## Nouns

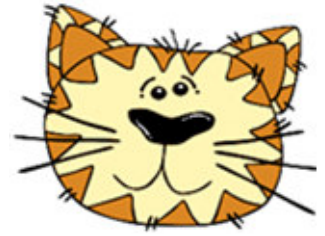
**A noun is a word used to name a person, a place, or a thing.**
