They give birth to live young and babies drink milk from their mother.

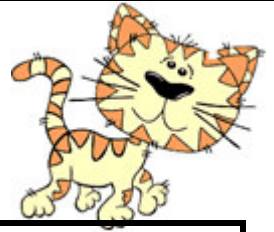
2. They are warm – blooded animals with feathers and wings. They lay eggs, and most can fly.
